Company	The Boeing Company was incorporated in 1934 under the laws of the State of Delaware, under the name "Boeing Airplane Company". Its present name was adopted in 1961. The Boeing Company is the world's leading aerospace company and the largest manufacturer of commercial jetliners and military aircraft combined. The Boeing Company is headquartered in Chicago, 100 North Riverside, Chicago, Illinois, 60606, USA.
Shares	The Boeing Company had 1,012,478,589 shares of common stock, 5 USD par value, issued and outstanding as of June 30, 2010. The shares of common stock of The Boeing Company have a primary listing on the New York Stock Exchange (NYSE) and – among others - a secondary listing on the SIX Swiss Exchange.
Delisting	The SIX Swiss Exchange has approved the application for delisting of the Company's shares of common stock from the SIX Swiss Exchange. The last trading day will be 11 January 2011, delisting will take place on 12 January 2011. The delisting from the SIX Swiss Exchange does not affect the listing on the NYSE. The shares of The Boeing Company continue to be traded on the NYSE.
