### Delisting Repower AG, Brusio

On 25 November 2015, Repower AG applied for the delisting of all of its listed bearer shares (Swiss Security Number 1'640'583 / ISIN CH0016405836) with a par value of CHF 1 each and of all of its listed participation certificates (Swiss Security Number 1'640'584 / ISIN CH0016405844) with a par value of CHF 1 each. SIX Exchange Regulation granted this application on 17 December 2015. The delisting takes place on 29 April 2016, the last trading day on SIX Swiss Exchange will be on 28 April 2016.
