Cham Group AG has announced, that all of its listed registered shares (Swiss Security Number 193'185 / ISIN CH0001931853) with a nominal value of CHF 65 will be delisted at SIX. SIX Exchange Regulation AG has granted the companies' application on 13 August 2019.
